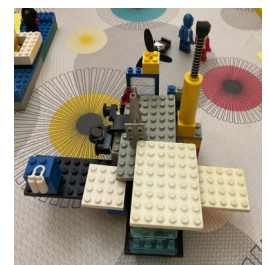
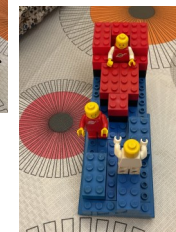
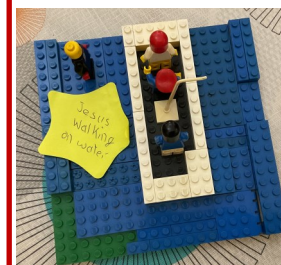


We are looking for volunteers to join the cleaning to to just help out once a month. If you feel this is something you can help with, please see Sharon Wills.
