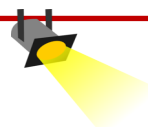


Explore Life Faith Meaning

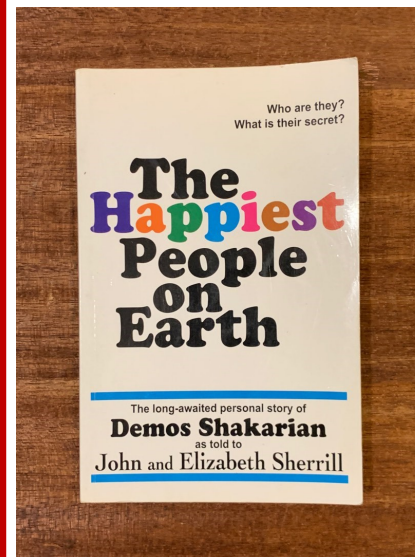
I had a conversation with a woman who brings her kids to the youth groups, she said they were amazed at what we do and was very grateful.
